Natural Wines

“Natural wine is not new; it is what wine always was, and yet, somehow today it has become a rarity. It is a tiny drop in a big ocean, but, oh my, what a drop.”

So what is natural wines, according to latest edition of *The Oxford Companion to Wine*:

- Grapes are typically grown by small-scale, independent producers.
- Grapes are hand-picked from sustainable, organic, or biodynamic vineyards.
- Wine is fermented with no added yeast (ie. native yeasts).
- No additives are included in fermentation (yeast nutrients, etc).
- Little or no sulfites are added.
- Of course, there is no official or regulated definition of natural wine.

Below are a few well known examples for Natural Wines

Biodynamic Wines

Biodynamic wines are produced using biodynamic methods both in growing the fruit and during the post harvest process.

Biodynamic wine production uses organic farming methods, while also employing soil supplements prepared according to

Rudolf Steiner's formulas, following a planting calendar that depends upon astrological configurations, and treating the earth as “a living and receptive organism.”

Organic Wines

Is wine made from grapes grown in accordance with the principles of organic farming, which excludes the use of artificial chemical fertilizers, pesticides, fungicides, and herbicides.

Orange Wines

Orange wine is also called “amber wine” or “ramato,” which means auburn, in Italian and describes skin-contact Pinot Grigio wines from Friuli-Venezia Giulia. First things first: “orange wine” is not a type of wine made from a magical, orange grape. In short, orange wines are produced with white wine grapes but vinified as though they were red wines. This method results in skin-contact white wines, as the grapes are fermented in contact with their skins and yeast for anywhere from a few days to a few months.

This allows the wine to develop tannins, polyphenol, aromatic substances and proteins that render the final wine completely different from both white and red wines from a visual, olfactory, and even textural point of view.

Fermentation in bottle

(Pétillant Naturel, or Pét-Nat) for short, is bottled prior to fully completing its first fermentation, allowing carbon dioxide to be produced by the natural sugars found in the grapes. This method is typically preferred to the méthode champenoise by natural wine producers.

PREMIUM WINE BY GLASS 150ML

The Coravin Wine Preservation Opener uses a hollowed needle, which is inserted through the cork and fills the bottle with argon gas to pressurize it, and the wine, in turn, is poured through the needle. When the needle is removed from the cork, the cork reseals, protecting the wine from oxidation and leaving the remaining wine unaffected.

SAKE

*Sake, known in Japan as Nihonshu (日本酒), is a traditional Japanese alcoholic beverage produced through the fermentation of rice, water, yeast, and koji mold (*Aspergillus oryzae*). While often referred to as "rice wine" in English its brewing process, is technically more similar to that of beer.*

Rice (Sakamai): *Specialized, high-quality rice (shuzo kotekimai) is used, which has larger grains and less protein/fat than table rice. (Yamada Nishiki, Gohyakumangoku, Miyama Nishiki, Omachi).*

Water: *Essential for the taste, with soft water often producing sweet sake and hard water producing dry, crisp styles.*

Koji-kin (*Aspergillus oryzae*): *A mold that converts rice starch into fermentable sugars.*

Yeast: *Responsible for converting sugars into alcohol.*

Process: *Unlike beer, where starch conversion and fermentation happen separately, sake utilizes Multiple Parallel Fermentation, where starch conversion to sugar and sugar conversion to alcohol occur simultaneously in the same tank.*

Main Classifications of Sake

Junmai (純米): *Pure rice sake, meaning no distilled alcohol is added.*

Junmai Daiginjo: *Highest grade with 50% minimum or below polished and produced by slowly fermenting rice at low temperatures of 5 to 10 degrees Celsius*

Honjozo (本醸造): *A small amount of alcohol is added to lighten the flavor and boost aroma.*

Ginjo (吟醸): *Polished at least 40% fermented at low temperatures for fruity/floral flavors.*

Daiginjo (大吟醸): *The highest grade, with 50% or more of the grain polished away.*

Nigori (濁り): *Roughly filtered, leaving rice sediment and a milky appearance.*

Namazake (生酒): *Unpasteurized, fresh, and requires refrigeration.*

Serving and Etiquette

Served in small cups (ochoko), wooden boxes (masu), or wine glasses.

Sake Meter Value (SMV)

Higher positive numbers being drier and lower negative numbers being sweeter.

Umeshu (梅酒)

Umeshu is a popular Japanese plum liqueur made by steeping fresh ume plums in sugar and alcohol, typically shochu. It has a sweet and sour flavor profile, usually around 10–15% ABV, and is often enjoyed chilled, on the rocks, or with soda.
